This will be at the discretion of Tommerup's Dairy Farm.</p>
11.45am – 11.55am	<p>Board bus to return to Farm 1 – 2142 Kerry Road, Kerry.</p>	<p>Allows time for a quick drink and any urgent toilet stops.</p>
