10 - 10.30am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive on farm - 2142 Kerry Road, Kerry • Orientation and farm rules discussion • Toilet break • Morning tea 	<p>Please aim to arrive on farm during this timeframe. This will allow your students to have maximum learning time on our farm. Please bring all food and drinks (including water) for your group. There are no nearby shops.</p>
10.30 - 10.40am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board bus and drive to Tommerup's dairy - 2105 Kerry Road, Kerry. 	<p>Located on the opposite side of the road to the meeting point - approx 1km.</p>
10.40am- 12pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dairy & Milking Demonstration • Visit the calf yards • Milk Transportation • Milk & milk products, cream separating and butter making • Tour of the historical home built in 1888 	<p>Students will view the milking rather than participate. This is always an activity where interesting discussion and questions are generated. Open conversations where student and teacher questions often guide the direction of the content discussed.</p>
12 - 12.25pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board bus to return to Farm 1 - 2142 Kerry Road, Kerry • Lunch and Toilet Break 	<p>This is flexible however we find it works to have lunch and then a longer session after to allow food to settle before the bus ride home!</p>
12.30 - 1.30pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smashing Pumpkins pig feeding • Meet & Feed the farm animals • Incorporating discussion and observations of - Animal products - Life Cycles of Farm Animals - Roles of a farmer - Paddock to Plate food production on our farm 	<p>Hand feed our farm animals; learn what role they play on both our farm and other farming enterprises. Hands-on activity. Time for open discussions and questions from students and supervisors.</p>
